

Prize Draw Terms and Conditions template:

1. No purchase necessary to enter the prize draw

The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any entries that are incomplete, illegible, corrupted or fail to reach the Promoter by the relevant closing date for any reason. 4. Only one entry per person. No entrant may win more than one prize.
